# CREATING A HOME-LIKE ENVIRONMENT FOR HOSPICE RESIDENTS

Since 2018, SASHA's donation provided essential furniture and amenities to support our 10-bed hospice unit, impacting over **268 families** in the past two years. Each item addresses critical gaps in care which has improved residents' well-being and the experience of their families.

## 10 SMART TVS

At end of life, a smart TV creates a home-like environment by offering families a way to connect through movies, soothing music, and cherished photos.

## 11 SLEEPER CHAIRS + RECLINERS

Sleeper chairs provide a space for families to stay close to their loved ones. These recliners help enhance their quality of life and maintain comfort.

## 3 CENTRELLA SMART BEDS

These state-of-the-art hospital beds offer advanced comfort and safety features. They improve pain management and overall quality of rest for residents.

## 2 BRODA CHAIRS

These specialized chairs offer features like reclining, tilt, and extra padding which bridge the gap between standard wheelchairs and the specialized support they need.

## 10 FRIDGE CABINETS

These cabinets are designed to elevate fridges off the floor, allowing for easier access and reducing the need to bend, making it more comfortable for residents.

## ADAPTIVE GOWNS

Adaptive gowns simplify the dressing process and ensure comfort for residents who may have difficulty with traditional hospital gowns.
